If (2) eligible Tuna are caught the prize money will be split 70% for 1st and 30% for 2nd Place. If no eligible Tuna are caught in the Calcutta B, all money will be returned to the entries. Calcutta is for the largest overall qualifying Tuna.

Heaviest Tuna takes Calcutta C Pot. If no eligible Tuna in the Calcutta C, the Calcutta C pool money will be returned to the entries. Calcutta is for the largest overall qualifying Tuna.

Calcutta is for the largest overall qualifying Mahi.

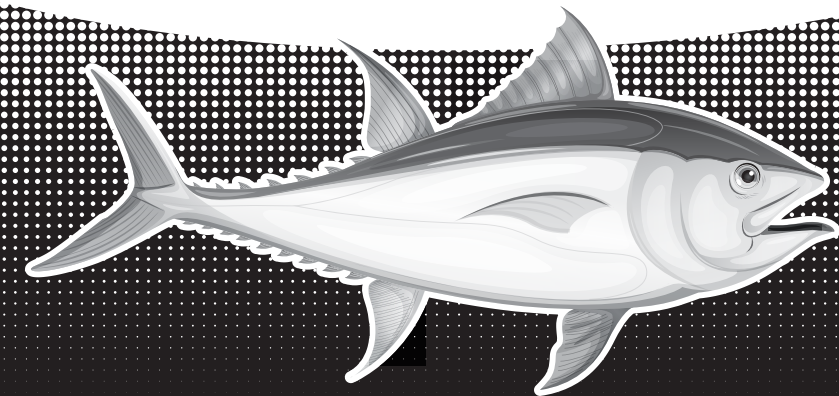

JCSA "KIDS WITH CANCER TOURNAMENT" RULES AND REGULATIONS 2022

- 1 At least one member must attend the captains' meeting.
- 2 All state and federal regulations apply.
- 3 Fish species available for weigh-in awards are yellowfin tuna, longfin tuna, bigeye tuna, dolphin. Bluefin tuna are eligible for awards up to 73".
- 4 All tackle IGFA Rules apply with the exception that spreader bars with hooks are permitted.
- 5 All Participants are assumed to have all necessary permits and registrations. For permit & registration visit www.nmfspermits.com & www.nj.gov/dep/saltwaterregistry.
- 6 All boats must return to Manasquan Inlet with fish to be weighed at Capt. Bill's Landing 4pm - 7pm.
- 7 There is a maximum of 125 Nautical miles from The Manasquan Inlet Sea Bouy.
- 8 Boats may not leave their inlet before 12am Saturday and must be inside Manasquan Inlet by 7pm Sunday. No weigh-ins on Saturday.
- 9 Any boat leaving their inlet before Midnight will be disqualified!
- 10 VHF Channel 72 will be the channel for all tournament related communications and channel 65 would be the alternate.
- 11 In the event of a participating boat being disabled prior to declared fishing day they may transfer to a substitute vessel and use the disabled vessels boat number. Any and all calcutta money from the disabled vessel will be transferred to the new vessel. The disabled and the new vessel MUST BE REPORTED TO THE JCSA COMMITTEE PRIOR TO DEPARTURE.
- 12 All boats returning to their inlets Even if they do not have a fish to weigh MUST REPORT THEY ARE IN PORT SAFELY. THIS IS MANDATORY!
- 13 There will be no transferring of fish from boat to boat.
- 14 Upon weighing in your fish, the angler who landed the fish will be required to fill out Official JCSA Weigh slip that must be signed by the angler and the weigh master.
- 15 This is a trolling, jigging or chunking tournament.
- 16 USE OF HARPOONS, GREENSTICKS AND BANDIT GEAR IS PROHIBITED! USE OF DRONES, SPOTTER PLANES OR AERIAL FISH LOCATION DEVICES PROHIBITED.
- 17 Any protests must be made to the JCSA Weigh master while the fish is hanging on the scale. The weigh master shall serve as judge and all his decisions are final!
- 18 JCSA reserves the right to engage a marine biologist to determine species freshness, and condition in any protest.
- 19 The tournament directors, Sponsors, and hosting facility assume NO LIABILITY OR RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY DAMAGES OR LOSS.
- 20 All winners will be required to submit their social security number and photo ID before prizes will be rewarded. They MUST fill out all required paperwork and a 1099 will be issued...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 21 In the event that the tournament is not filled 100% a straight % of cash prizes will be awarded based on the amount of boats entered. In the event of a tie, prize will be split equally.
- 22 If no 2nd and 3rd place fish are weighed in all monies will go to 1st place. If no 3rd place, 1st & 2nd will split 3rd place money 60/40.
- 23 All interpretation of the rules and final decisions will rest with the JCSA.
- 24 The JCSA reserves the right to deny entry to any vessel for any reason.
- 25 THE CAPTAIN IS SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF HIS CREW AND VESSEL.
- 26 The Tournament may be cancelled or postponed by the Tournament Committee.
- 27 In the event that the Tournament is cancelled or no eligible tuna are landed the winner will be determined by a drawing.
- 28 All Calcutta money less 10% charitable donations to Kids with Cancer.
